About the fund

The fund was established by Burnetts Solicitors to support local communities, including students at Cockermouth School.

Grants will support young people prioritising those facing 'challenging circumstances', including those from low-income households, or with exceptional talents, for educational purposes such as training costs or foreign travel.



What will we fund?

Activities that help to raise educational attainment and career aspirations.

For example:

- school trips
- overseas competitions
- work experience
- an instrument for a talented musician
- a theatre workshop for a talented actor
- training costs for an aspiring athlete

Who can apply?

Those experiencing 'challenging circumstances' For example:

- low-income household
- care-experienced
- young carer
- recent bereavement or diagnosis of terminal illness of a close relative e.g. parent / sibling
- exceptional talent needing specialist training and equipment
