

Cockermouth School and Community Association's 100 Club Rules



Welcome to Cockermouth School and Community Association's 100 Club. Membership is open to all parents, carers and friends of Cockermouth School.

This is your chance to win £100 every month (October to July) and help school's fundraising efforts.

Terms and Conditions

We have a small lottery license which means we can hold a 100 club lottery.

Once we have received your payment, you will be contacted with your membership number. This is the number that will be entered into our lottery draw each month. For example number 56.

We commit to drawing a winner every month 10 times per year, October to July, and publicising the winner on our Cockermouth School and Community Association Facebook page. We will share this information with school but cannot guarantee that they share the information.

Payment to the 100 Club

It's easy to set up by one of our 2 methods;

1. By completing a Standing Order with your own bank, you only have to sign up once. Simply set up the Standing Order for £12 to Bank Account 30272760, Sort Code 20-66-97 Account Name Cockermouth School Association 100 Club. Make sure this is an **annual payment** NOT monthly.
2. If your child is currently at Cockermouth School, you can pay using school's online payment system called Squid. Look in Offers to find the 100 Club. Follow the steps to pay your £12 for a year. Payment on Squid is only open from 1st August to the end of October every year. You will need to pay every year that you wish to be in the draw. You will be notified by email in November that you have been entered into the draw for the year.

If you wish to sign up more than once, you will be given a number for each £12 you pay.

Drawing the winner

All payees are entered into the draw once payments have been received into the bank account or by Squid by the end of each month. Due to delays in receiving bank statements, the draw for October will take place in mid-November, November's draw in mid-December, and continue the same way up to July's draw in mid-August.

A member of the CSCA committee (usually the Treasurer) will select the winner using the website Wheel of Names (wheelofnames.com). All names and numbers are entered into the 'wheel' and then 'spun' using this electronic selection tool. Draws are filmed and added to the CSCA Facebook page. Members names are not saved on Wheel of Names.

If you win, you will be notified by email or by phone. If you joined prior to July 2023, and we don't have your email address or phone number, we will write to you.

The prize

The prize from October 2023 will be £100 each month. There will be no second or third place winners. We reserve the right to change this at some point in the future by giving notice to the club's members on the Facebook page and Squid.

Payment to the winners

We will pay the winnings into your bank account within 2 weeks of the draw taking place. This will be paid into the bank account that is registered for your standing order.

If you signed up on Squid, we will contact you for your bank details as they are not held on record.

Cancellation

Membership will continue until you cancel your standing order. If you wish to cancel your membership you should cancel your standing order with your own bank and notify the CSCA by emailing cscaqueries@gmail.com. If your message is not acknowledged please contact us again. The CSCA is run by volunteers and emails may not be responded to immediately.

If you decide to leave part way through the year, we reserve the right not to reimburse your payment in full or in part but no future payments will be taken. If you notify us too close to the standing order date (usually around 3 working days in advance) they may not be able to stop the standing order and we reserve the right not to issue a refund.

If you have paid on Squid, you will only be a member of the 100 club in the year that you paid. If you decide to leave part way through the year, we reserve the right not to reimburse your payment in full or in part but no future payments will be taken.

GDPR

We will only publicise your name and number in the winner's announcement.

By opting into the lottery, you consent to us holding your information for the purposes of the lottery only. You consent to us contacting you about the lottery. We will not sell or use your data for any other purposes. Your data will be held securely and password protected. When you are no longer in the 100 club we will securely destroy any paper application forms and delete electronic records at the end of the financial year (31st August).
