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INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2021

All applications for school places for September 2021 have to be made via the Council website: <u>http://www.solihull.gov.uk/admissions</u>. If you live outside Solihull you must apply to your local council even if you want to include Solihull schools on your application.

Information for Year 6 Parents – applying for a Secondary School place for September 2021

Children with a date of birth between 1st September 2009 and 31st August 2010 (current Year 6) transfer to secondary school in September 2021. Please ensure that you apply online before the closing date which is **31st October 2020**. Offer day is 1st March 2021.

Information for Nursery Parents – applying for a Reception place for September 2021

Children with a date of birth between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017 start full-time school in September 2021. This first year is called 'Reception'. Please ensure that you apply online before the closing date which is **15th January 2021.** Offer day is 16th April 2021.

Applying for a Nursery school place for September 2021

If your child was born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018 you can apply for 30 hours free Nursery education in a Solihull school starting in September 2021. These applications are now made directly to schools and not via Admissions. CHS offer 15 hours a week (5 x 3 hour sessions). The additional 15 hours can be applied for at Chuckles and Chums (if entitled). Please email the school office on <u>office@chs.solihull.sch.uk</u>, telephone 0121 779 8070 or call into the school office for an application form.

Please note that all admissions are now completed online (with the exception of Nursery). If you do not have access to a computer you can visit any library and use the computers there. Please do not miss the deadlines and please ensure that you complete the form with admissions.

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Concerns – Safety of Parking/Entrance Access – We need you to:

- Reduce your speed in and around the school site. The speed limit is 5mph on school property. Be observant when reversing and when driving through the walkway at each entrance.
- Park legally, and with consideration to residents and others, leaving access to the school and resident's driveways free.
- **Keep music and noise down** as some residents work shifts so may be trying to sleep.
- Do not park under the barrier or on the curved part of the front entrance, delivery vehicles need to have access and this causes a safety hazard. If you park in this way and your vehicle is damaged the school is <u>not</u> responsible.
- > Ideally, park away from the school site and walk in, this will ease congestion.

We all have a responsibility and nothing comes before the safety and well-being of the children and school community. Please help us to be a safe and happy community, give a bit of thought and show respect and kindness to others, but more importantly **think of the lives and safety of young innocent children**.

School Meals

Reception, Years 1 and 2 are entitled to a free school meal regardless of a parent's income. Year 3 upwards, as you are aware, are now required to pay for your child's school dinners as they will no longer qualify for the Government's Universal Infant Free School meals programme. Some families may be entitled to continue claiming free school meals depending on family income - if you would like to apply for free school meals, please do so via the Solihull council website at: http://www.solihull.gov.uk/fsm. Families that do not qualify will be charged for each school meal their child has; payment is to be made online via ParentPay or at any PayPoint.

Prices from 1st September 2020: a school dinner for one child will cost: £2.20 per day /is £11.00 per 5-day week.
