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#### **INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2025**

All applications for school places for September 2026 have to be made via the Council website:

http://www.solihull.gov.uk/admissions. Parents need to apply on the portal under the home authority that they live within even if you want to include Solihull schools on your application. Children with EHCP's follow a different process, they should contact their EHCP officer.

### Information for Year 6 Parents – applying for a Secondary School place for September 2026

Children with a date of birth between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2014 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015 (current Year 6) transfer to secondary school in September 2026. Please ensure that you apply online before the closing date: **31<sup>st</sup> October 2025**. Offer day is 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026.

#### Information for Nursery Parents – applying for a Reception place for September 2026

Children with a date of birth between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022 start full-time school in September 2026. This first year is called 'Reception'. Please ensure that you apply online for a school place through the council website/portal (which is now open) before the closing date: **15**<sup>th</sup> **January 2026.** Offer day is 16<sup>th</sup> April 2026. Children that attend our Nursery still need to apply.

On Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> October Reception had an Open Day where parents and children had the opportunity to view the classroom spaces/outdoor area and ask questions.

#### Applying for a Nursery school place

We currently have spaces available in our Nursery for children who have turned 3-years-old. Children can start with us the term after they turn 3 years old and they are entitled to 15 hours of Nursery education (AM or PM daily sessions). You can also apply online for 30 hours of free Nursery education via the Government website at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/30-hours-free-childcare">https://www.gov.uk/30-hours-free-childcare</a> (certain criteria apply).

On Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> October you were invited to visit our nursery provision for 2 and 3 year olds to explore our well-resourced environment, ask any questions, get help with applications and find out about our Early Years ethos at CHS.

Please note that all admissions are now completed online (with the exception of Nursery). If you do not have access to a computer you can visit any library and use the computers there. To ensure your space, please do not miss the deadlines specified and please ensure that you complete the appropriate admissions forms.

#### 2 Year and 3-4 Year Provisions

#### **Nursery 2-Year-Old Provision**

Children who are 2 years old may be entitled to a free nursery place for up to 15 hours per week. Please use the following link to check if you are eligible:

#### **Nursery 3- and 4-Year Olds**

All children aged 3 to 4 years are entitled to 15 hours of early education funding per week the term after their 3rd birthday.

Application forms for 2 year old and 3 year old places are available from the school office. Children can begin the term following their  $2^{nd}$  or  $3^{rd}$  birthday and when funding codes have been secured. For any questions please email 150 office@chs.solihull.sch.uk

#### School Meals when your child moves from Year 2 to Year 3

As your child moves up to Year 3 in September this year, they will no longer be entitled to a Free School Meal under the 'Universal Infant Free School Meals' scheme, which provides all children from Reception to Year 2 with a free school meal. Therefore, if you would like us to continue to provide your child with school meals from September, then there will be a charge for this of £3.00 per day, unless your child is eligible for free school meals due to your household circumstances. This is payable in advance via ParentPay or at any PayPoint.

To find out if your child is entitled to free school meals, then please apply via: <a href="www.solihull.gov.uk/fsm">www.solihull.gov.uk/fsm</a> School will be informed of the outcome of your application. Alternatively, you may provide your child with a packed lunch from home.

If your child will be arriving at school after 10.30am, and requires a school dinner, please call the school office to order this before 10.30 am. Otherwise, they will only be able to have a sandwich. Thank you in advance for your co-operation in this matter.

#### Improving Communication Links with School

To keep your child/ren safe and ensure their well-being, we are constantly looking for ways to improve our links with you and keep everyone up-to-date and well informed. As sending written information home is sometimes unreliable; we are continuing to use Schoolcomms, an electronic school communication system. This will enable you to receive all your information from school quickly and reliably. We can send letters by email to your inbox and short messages directly to your mobile phone as a text message, or if you have an Apple or Android mobile phone, by app message. In addition to Schoolcomms, we also use ParentPay for trips, dinner money etc and Class Dojo for communicating with parents.

<u>URGENT: Keep the office informed of your current mobile number and email address</u>. If you are not receiving <u>communication by these sources please contact the school office and they will look into the reason why</u>. Help us to help you, thank you. Limited information can also be found on our website and noticeboards around school.

### Pupil/Privacy Notices

#### Important – Parking with consideration

Please be considerate to local residents that live in close proximity to the school when parking and refrain from playing loud music and dropping litter. <u>Please reduce your speed</u> in and around the school site. Speed limit to 5mph on school property. **Nothing comes before the safety and well-being of the children and school community.** 

#### Where's My Jumper

Please remember to put your child's name on EVERY item of uniform. If some of your child's uniform goes missing we have a much greater chance of returning it to you if a name is clearly printed on it.

We have some pupils at CHS who are allergic to nuts, so we have made CHS a nut free school for the safety of our children. No nuts or any snacks/food containing nuts are permitted in school ie peanut butter or chocolate spread. If you have any questions please feel free to contact your child's class teacher.
