

Expressive Arts & Design

- We will continue to learn and sing a variety of different songs and rhymes.
- We will be finding the pulse, rhythm and pitch in a piece of music and be talking about different types of music and instruments.
- We will have lots of opportunities to choose from a range of materials to design and make our own ideas through art.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will continue to work collaboratively so that we can play together co-operatively and take turns with our friends.
- We will build on the confidence we have developed so far and be able to confidently talk in a group and share our ideas, showing respect to ideas different to our own.

Understanding of the World

- We will be talking and thinking about how our environment differs to other peoples and places in the world. We will look at beaches in this country and how they differ to around the world.
- We will look at different types of technology and how and where they are used.
- Children will learn more about animals that live in water and similarities and differences between them.
- To learn about different cultures, interests and backgrounds in the UK and in other countries.

Physical Development

- P.E – Athletics – lots of moving around. Using javelins, jumping distances and heights, running races, team work, team games, balancing, target throwing, throwing and catching, long jump, high jump.
- We will have a really good pencil grip and be able to form all letters correctly.
- We will talk confidently about different ways to keep healthy.

Literacy

Writing

- We will write simple sentences independently using our phonic skills and read back what we have written.
- We will spell our words using 'Fred fingers'. We will use finger spaces and take care over the size and formation of the letters we write, ending with a full stop.

Reading

- Learn our new non – fiction text – What is a Shark?
- We will work hard to read multisyllabic words, read tricky red words, and high frequency words.
- We will answer questions about a text we have read.

Number

- We will learn to count reliably with numbers from one to 20 and recognise and write them. They will be able to count on from any number to 20.
- To solve problems of doubling, halving and sharing.

Mathematics - Shape, Space and Measure

Communication & Language
