How Foster Carers Get Support They Need

Solihull Council's Training Team use the community hubs to deliver support to local foster carers. The hubs provide a safe and comfortable space for carers to relax, network and learn more about the job they do. The team help train carers in the skill of supporting children with emotional difficulties following their separation from their families. The foster carers are able to learn how to give better support to these children by having more understanding of their difficulties and needs. This helps foster carer's improve on what they do and also provides them with a support network of their own.

An extra advantage of users accessing the hubs is the exposure to more information and connections of other activities and services on offer. Such as computing and literacy courses available for them to improve their CV. Yvonne Saidi, one of the trainers says: "We love using the hubs and very much value the amazing support of Sue Watson, the community development manager. Without the hubs, we would struggle to deliver this valuable support."
