Activities include bingo, arts & crafts, quizzes, coach trips, meals out, pamper sessions, bring and buy sales, speakers and much more. They all enjoy a buffet lunch and refreshments. Through the group members have improved their confidence, self esteem and independence and many have shared their talents. Capitol House Hub at Yorkswood School

Since the hub moved into Capitol House from the temporary building on site, the baby clinic has been running each week for local mums. Various other activities have also been developing for parents of children who attend the school including: Stay and Play; Yoga; a slimming club; family music workshop; mental health support; a craft group run by Solihull College and parenting support run by Barnardo's. In addition, to support young people, a youth club, run by volunteers, takes place in the centre each week.

Following work already carried out to enable a multi faceted facility at Capitol House, plans are underway to improve access and surrounding landscaping, which is part of the new school building project due to be completed soon.
