As a registered charity since 2002, we have supported individuals & groups that are often marginalised due to disability, poverty and mental health related issues.

Originally started in partnership with Solihull Council, as Waterloo Woodwork; an initiative to support learning disabled adults, the project now operates as a social enterprise. We deliver assembly, packing and component kitting services to a number of industries, including automotive, health & beauty and building supplies. We provide positive outcomes for a broad range of ages and abilities.

Many of the people that participate with us, have gone on to secure employment elsewhere. We have an employment and skills team who have been successfully helping local people into work and training for over 16 years.
