

Year 1 Art Home Learning Challenges

- Try as many of the activity as possible
- You can use as many different materials as your can, e.g. pen, pencil, crayon, paint, digital images etc.

Drawing:

- ◆ Draw around objects in your home to create a picture in the style of Kandinski or Renata Berenal [Google these artists]
- ◆ Take your pencil for a walk around a piece of paper. Create a random picture and then colour sections of the paper in different vibrant colours. Look at Jackson Pollock for ideas of taking a pencil for a walk.
- Choose at least 10 different items from your home and have a go at drawing them. Look at the shapes they create and practise your drawing skills
- Using an A5 piece of paper, draw some different types of lines to create the sun and a sunset pictures. Make it colourful.



Sculpture:

- Use newspapers, magazines any junk in the recycling bin to build and create a model of your choice.
- Use kitchen pots and pans to create a model and take a picture of it.
- Create a collage of a picture of your choice using cut out pictures form magazines and newspapers.
- ♦ Wikiart Beatriz Milhazes webpage: Create a piece of abstract art using circles. Have lots of coloured paper circles, different sizes where possible and the children experiment with composition, moving the shapes around to create an interesting abstract art. They can cut the shapes in half. Then glue down their shapes to create their

Printing and digital media:

- Use objects to create prints, e.g. vegetables, fruit or sponges
- Natural objects to create prints [picked from the garden] Make rubbings of leaves
- Press spring flowers and create a picture.
- Using a phone or camera, take lots of photos around your home. Look for weird shapes and patterns and then see if your can make a collage on screen using the different pictures [adult led activity on the computer]
