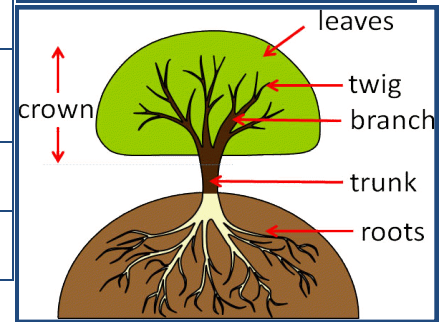
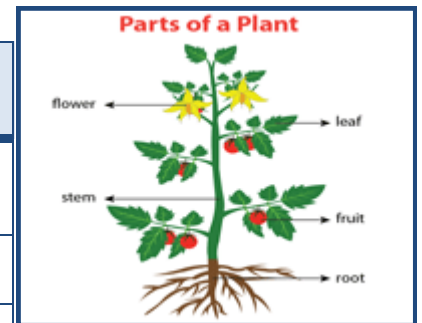


Parts of a	Their function
roots	Hold the plant in the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the
stem	Transports water and nutrients to different parts of the plant.
leaves	Use light, air and water to make food for the plant.
flower	The part of a plant that blossoms. Flowers produce seeds that form
petals	Attract insects using their bright colours or unusual shapes
seeds	The part of a plant from which a new plant grows.

Types of trees

Deciduous– Trees which lose their leaves in winter.

Evergreen—Trees which keep their leaves all year round.
