**INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2020** 

All applications for school places for September 2020 have to be made via the Council website: http://www.solihull.gov.uk/admissions. If you live outside Solihull you must apply to your local council even if you want to include Solihull schools on your application. Please note that all admissions (except Nursery) are now done online. If you do not have access to a computer you can visit any library and use the computers there. Please do not miss the deadlines and please ensure that you complete the form with admissions.

Applying for a Nursery school place for September 2020

If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017 you can apply for 30 hours free Nursery education in a Solihull school starting in September 2020. These applications are now made directly to schools and not via Admissions. CHS offer 15 hours a week (5 x 3 hour sessions). The additional 15 hours can be applied for at Chuckles and Chums (if entitled).
