What is LMI?

LMI stands for "Labour Market Information" and it can tell us;

- Where the jobs are currently located and which job opportunities are growing or declining
- The skills that might be needed now and in the future
- The size of the industry and what changes might be seen or predicted in the future
- Where shortages of workers, skills and jobs may be now and in the future
- Hours, pay, job skills, working day for a variety of industries and job roles
- ▶ How to move into that industry or job role e.g. entry routes, courses, study and qualifications

This information can help with your future career choices and may help you to decide what additional courses and skills might be needed before you apply!
