Setting: In a restaurant

Scenario:

- You are asking for a table at a restaurant.
- The teacher will play the part of the waiter and will speak first.
- The teacher will ask questions in Spanish and you must answer in Spanish.
- Say a few words or a short phrase/sentence for each prompt. One-word answers are not sufficient to gain full marks.

Task:

- 1 Say where you would like a table.
- 2 Say what you would like to drink.
- 3 Ask the price of something on the menu.
- 4 Say what you are going to do this afternoon.
- 5 Ask a question about where the toilet is.

e.g. 'I would like a table outside.'

Start with 'How much...?'

Use the near future tense.

You could use the word for 'bathroom' here.

- 4 What do you think the verb **esperar** means?

Describe this picture:

Your description must cover:

- people
- location
- activity.

When you have finished your description, you will be asked **two questions** relating to the picture. Say a **short phrase/sentence** in response to each question.

One-word answers will not be sufficient to gain full marks.

You will then move on to a **conversation** on the broader thematic context of **Travel and tourism**.

During the conversation, you will be asked questions in the present, past and future tenses.

Your responses should be as **full and detailed** as possible.

To talk about what someone is doing you can simply use the **present tense**. In Module 3 you will also learn to use a tense called the present continuous.
