What we do

Sometimes school can be challenging and if you or your teachers feel like you need extra support, that is when we step in! The Teaching Assistants can help with all sorts of things, such as supporting you in your lessons or helping you find your way around the school and they will always be ready to listen to any questions you may have.

What happens in XL

Our XL base in F Block (opposite the Art rooms) has 3 main sections:

 The Student Work Room (F0-10) supports those who are not accessing learning in lessons for a variety of reasons. Students using this facility have work provided by the subject staff or follow a curriculum that aligns with the whole-school curriculum. This allows students to fully engage with their learning and strive for academic excellence.



- **Thrive** (F0-14) is a space for students to receive interventions tailored to their individual needs and for supporting students with self-regulation strategies.
- The **Sensory Room** is available for students to help regulate their emotions.

Our SEND team can be found in XL, where you will find lots of resources to help you with your learning, such as laptops and Reader Pens. You may also call into the XL office if you have any questions or concerns.

Break and Lunchtimes



You are welcome to come to XL at break and lunchtimes to eat your snacks and lunch. You will also find a water fountain there. At lunchtimes there will be lots of games for you to play with your friends.

There will always be Teaching Assistants on duty at break and lunchtime, so if you have any worries or need any help let them know and they will be happy to help

you.

The School Day

8.30 am 8.40 am	Arrive at school Registration	When you arrive at school, you can go to the hall and get a free drink and some toast and talk to your friends. You can also go to XL, where the SEN team and some of the teaching assistants will be able to help you get organised for the day. A bell will ring to tell you it is time to go to registration. When the first bell goes, it is time for registration. This happens in your Form Room with your Tutor Group. Some days you will have an assembly and other days you will read or catch up with the news. Your Form Tutor will tell you when it is time to go to your first lesson. You can also check your timetable to see
9.10 am	Period 1	which lesson you have first. You will now go to your first lesson of the day. Do not worry about getting lost; you will quickly find your way around the school, and there are plenty of staff members to help you. Your teacher will tell you when it is time to go to your next lesson.
10.10 am	Period 2	Your teacher will tell you when it is break time.
11.10 am	Break	You can buy a snack from the refectory or bring your own. It is a cashless system (you cannot use money). Your parents/carers can put money onto your account online, or there is a machine in school that you can put your money in to top-up your account. Year 7 have an area to go called the Quad, or you can come to XL. A bell will ring to tell you it is the end of break time.
11.30 am	Period 3	Your teacher will tell you when it is time to move to your next lesson
12.30 pm	Lunch	You can either bring a packed lunch from home or buy your lunch from the refectory. You can eat your lunch in the Quad or in XL. In one room there will be games to play. We have a quieter room for students who want to do some homework or chat with their friends. In the summer you can go out on to the field. A bell will ring to tell you it is the end of lunchtime.
1.10 pm	Period 4	Your teacher will tell you when to go to your next lesson.
2.10 pm	Period 5	Your teacher will tell you when it is home time.
3.10 pm	Home Time	There are lots of after school activities, which your Form Tutor will tell you about or you may wish to go to the Homework club in the Library.



Homework

Homework is set online on a website called <u>satchel:one</u>. All students are expected to do homework for each subject. Remember that we can help you with your homework in XL at lunchtime and you can go to the Homework Club in the Library. You can also email your teacher. If you ever start struggling with completing homework, let a member of staff know as soon as possible so we can help and support you.

Every day, you must bring the following equipment:

- 2 Black Pens and 1 Green Pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Pencil sharpener
- Rubber
- Calculator
- Protractor
- Compass

- A modern media suite with an editing studio
- Two drama and music rooms with a recording studio
- A full size, flood-lit 3G pitch and lots of playing fields and courts for hockey, football, rugby, tennis, netball, cricket and athletics
- An outdoor shelter, (The Quad) with tables and chairs so you can be outside regardless of the weather.
