Where to find us


Like all the other subject areas, we have our own area in school called XL. We have a large classroom, FO-10 which has computers for you to use.

The School Day

8.30 am	Arrive at school	When you arrive at school, you can go to the hall and get a free drink and some toast and talk to your friends. You can also go to XL, where Mrs Jakobsen and some of the teaching assistants will be able to help you get organised for the day. A bell will ring to tell you it is time to go to registration.
8.40 am	Registration	When the first bell goes, it is time for registration. This happens in your Form Room with your Tutor Group. Some days you will have an assembly and other days you will read or catch up with the news. Your Form Tutor will tell you when it is time to go to your first lesson. You can also check your timetable to see which lesson you have first.
9.00 am	Period 1	You will now go to your first lesson of the day. Do not worry about getting lost; you will quickly find your way around the school, and there are plenty of staff members to help you. Your teacher will tell you when it is time to go to your next lesson.
10.00 am	Period 2	Your teacher will tell you when it is break time.
11.00 am	Break	You can buy a snack from the canteen or bring your own. It is a cashless system (you cannot use money). Your parents/carers can put money onto your account online, or there is a machine in school that you can put your money in to top-up your account. Year 7 have an area to go called the Quad, or you can come to XL. A bell will ring to tell you it is the end of break time.
11.20 am	Period 3	Your teacher will tell you when it is time to move to your next lesson
12.20 pm	Period 4	Your teacher will tell you when to go to your next lesson.
1.00 pm	Lunch	You can either bring a packed lunch from home or buy your lunch from the school canteen. You can eat your lunch in the Quad or in XL. In one room there will be games to play. We have a quieter room for students who want to do some homework or chat with their friends. In the summer you can go out on to the field. A bell will ring to tell you it is the end of lunchtime.
2.00 pm	Lesson 5	Your teacher will tell you when it is home time.
3.00 pm	Home Time	There are lots of after school activities, which you Form Tutor will tell you about or you may wish to go to the Homework club in the Library.



Homework


Homework is set online on a website called <u>satchelione</u>. All students are expected to do homework for each subject. Remember that we can help you with your homework in XL at lunchtime and you can go to the Homework Club in the Library. **You can also email your teacher**. If you ever start struggling with completing homework, let a member of staff know as soon as possible so we can help and support you.
