
## Attendance impact for one year

# Student Progress: Summer 2025 Exams



To help the students prepare for their exams:

- Regular mini assessments in classes to help the teachers and students evaluate the gaps in their knowledge and understanding to allow for re-teaching, revision and to help provide for intervention where necessary.
- On-going coursework in their Vocational subjects (where applicable).
- Mock Exams in November and March.

The 2025 exam schedule will come out in the New Year and the Public Exams are normally scheduled for May/June.




