Re: Sixth Form Experience Day

As part of the process to prepare our Sixth Form applicants for the demands of Post-16 study and for future pathways, we have planned a transition opportunity to be held over two days on **Monday 30**<sup>th</sup> **June and Tuesday 1**<sup>st</sup> **July** 

Monday 30th June will be held in school from 10 am until 2pm and will involve several activities to prepare students for Sixth Form life.

Tuesday 1st July will involve a visit to Edge Hill University; students will take part in a series of workshops that aim to prepare them for their Sixth Form studies, challenging them to think outside the box, improve resilience and help them to understand the need to access/utilise a range of resources and strategies to aid success.

On Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July, we will leave school at approximately 9am and return from Edge Hill University at 2:00pm. Although we expect to be back to school by 3.00pm, students who normally get one of the school buses must be aware that, if there are traffic delays, then they may need to make alternative arrangements to get home. Students are advised to bring a packed lunch but there may be opportunities to purchase refreshments. Any student who normally have a free school meal should indicate this on the consent form below and we will be able to sort this. The visit will be free of charge, but we do need to ensure that we have enough students to make the trip viable. We only have places for 40 students so it will be run on a first come, first served basis.

We strongly recommend that students who have applied to the Sixth Form attend the experience day as the trip to Edge Hill would be very useful for everyone but especially those students considering going to a university, even if it is not Edge Hill. Students will have the opportunity to ask about courses and university life. Further guidance about future choices will be given during Years 12 and 13.

We are required to ask for emergency contact details and relevant medical information. If you wish your child to take part, please complete the reply slip below and the Educational Visit Consent Form attached and return it in a sealed and labelled envelope to Student Reception marked Edge Hill University Trip by Friday 20th June. If students do not have a printer at home, they can collect a paper copy of the consent form from Reception.

We are very much looking forward to supporting students in their transition to the next stage of their academic/career journey. More details will soon follow on subject specific transition tasks



that will further prepare students for Sixth Form study.
