They can add or remove any subjects by clicking 'Manage Subjects' on the top right of the screen.

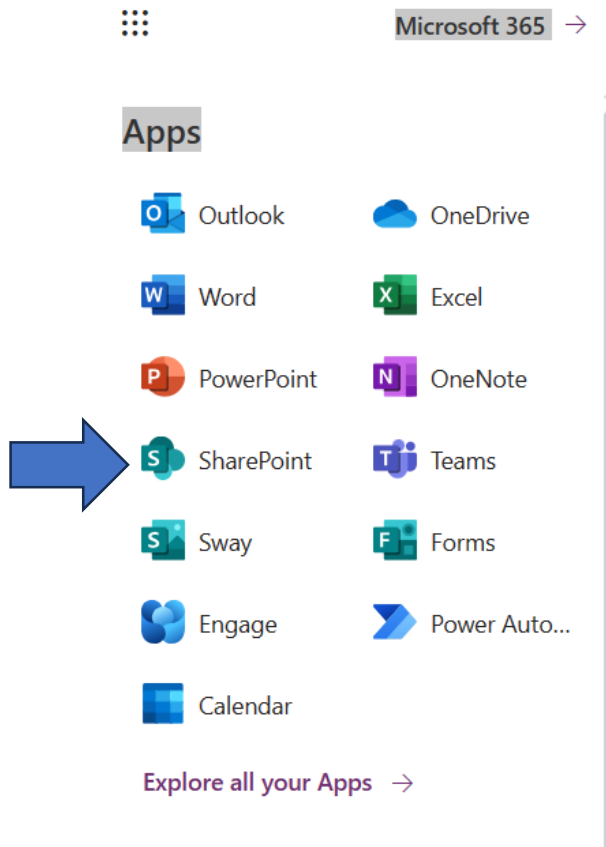
Manage My Subjects

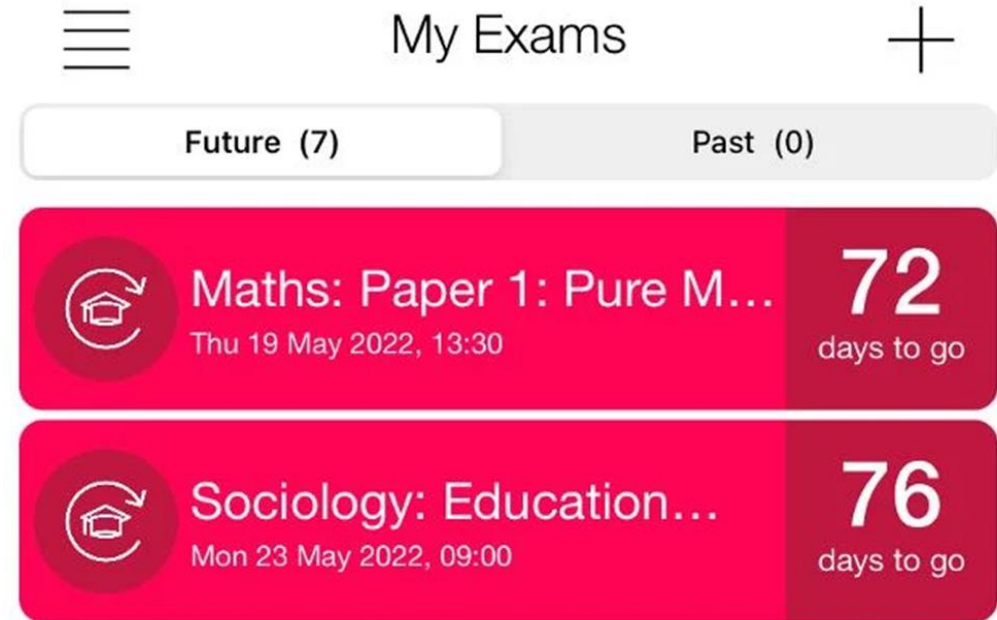

# Revision Apps – Exam countdown
