Agriculture	The practice of farming
Biome	A large region characterised by the plants and animals that live there and its climate.
Coniferous Forest	A forest with trees that don't lose their leaves.
Continent	7 Large areas of land. 6 of them have several countries in them.
Climate	The long term average weather conditions in an area.
Deciduous Forest	A forest with trees that lose their leaves.
Development	How a country improves over time
Earthquake	The sudden shaking of the ground caused by a release of pressure
Ecology	The study of plants and animals and how they interact with the environment
Economic	How money is made, used, and distributed in a country.
Himalayas	The name of a mountain range in Asia
Human Geography	This is all about people - where they live and what they do.
Landlocked	A region surrounded entirely by land
Migration	People moving from one place to another
Physical Geography	Natural things about planet Earth.
Population	How many people live in an area
Population density	How crowded are people in a place.
Primary Sector	An employment (jobs) sector where people collect raw materials, e.g. farmer
Raw material	A natural resource that is useful
Secondary Sector	An employment (jobs) sector where people work in manufacturing, e.g. factory worker
Subsistence farming	Growing crops only for your own use
Tectonic plate	A giant piece of the Earth's crust that moves
Tourism	Travel for fun and interest
Trade	Buying and selling of goods and services
Urbanisation	The process describing more people moving to towns and cities
