#### **Transition Days:**

These will be held on **Monday 30 June and Tuesday 1 July**; these sessions are open to all Year 11 students, including those of you not planning to enrol in Congleton Sixth Form College. Activities include a half-day in school and a free university visit.

There will also be tasks set for each subject to aid the transition to your Sixth Form studies.

From Monday 23 June, you will find full details on Teams (Year 11 Transition Team). Activities include:

- Subject-specific transition tasks (to be completed by September)
- Careers information and online courses – resources include: Unifrog, OpenLearn, FutureLearn; as well as CV and interview support if requested

#### **GCSE Results Day:**

GCSE examination results will be issued on **Thursday 21 August** and results can be collected between **9am and 11am from the Sixth Form Common Room**.

If you are unable to collect your results on 21 August and would like someone else to collect your results for you instead (by proxy), please email Miss Casey ([KCasey@CongletonHigh.com](mailto:KCasey@CongletonHigh.com)) with details of the person collecting your results (name and relationship to you). On Results Day, the person collecting them on your behalf must bring photo ID.
