Re: Year 11 Prom – Thursday 1th July 2024

The 'Class of 2024 Prom' has now been booked for Thursday 11th July 2024 at Shrigley Hall, Bollington, Near Macclesfield. This is an exclusive hotel which will provide a fabulous venue for our celebrations in making this a memorable event.

The evening will run as follows:

- Dress code is formal/evening wear Theme "A Night at the Oscars"
- Arrival from 6pm with a (non-alcoholic) welcome drink on arrival.
- A professional photographer has been booked to take individual and group photograph. These can be purchased on the night.
- Food will be provided and non-alcoholic drinks can be purchased from the hotel bar.
- After the food and speeches, we will dance the night away with a disco.
- The hotel will be providing a security service which will oversee the whole night
- Carriages at 10.00pm for 10.30pm.
- Anyone trying to purchase alcohol from the hotel bar, in possession of any alcohol, arriving intoxicated or in possession of any other prohibited substances, will be removed from the event and parents/carers will be called to collect.

The cost of the ticket is £50 with an initial deposit of £30 payable to Congleton High School by 15th March 2024. Payments can be made via the school's online payment. The remaining £20 will need to be paid by 3rd May at the very latest.

There will be a discount for some pupils based on the following:
