Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your support and cooperation during the first few days of the new term. I will be sending you a more detailed letter in the next few days, however I wanted to share some important information with you.

Firstly, I have been very impressed with the way that our students have adjusted to new ways of working at school and acting so responsibly as they move around school. The majority of the plans we have put in place are working and we continue to review things on a daily basis. As a result of observing things working in operation for the first few days of term, we can see there is too much congestion in the main building on the change over of lessons and have therefore decided to amend the one way system. Students will be given a full briefing of the new arrangements in an extended Registration this morning. We are confident that movement on the corridors will now be quicker and less congested.

As I said in my communication before the term started, we will continue to review our plans, and if needed, amend them accordingly.
