Percy Jackson and the Sea of Monsters by Rick Riordan

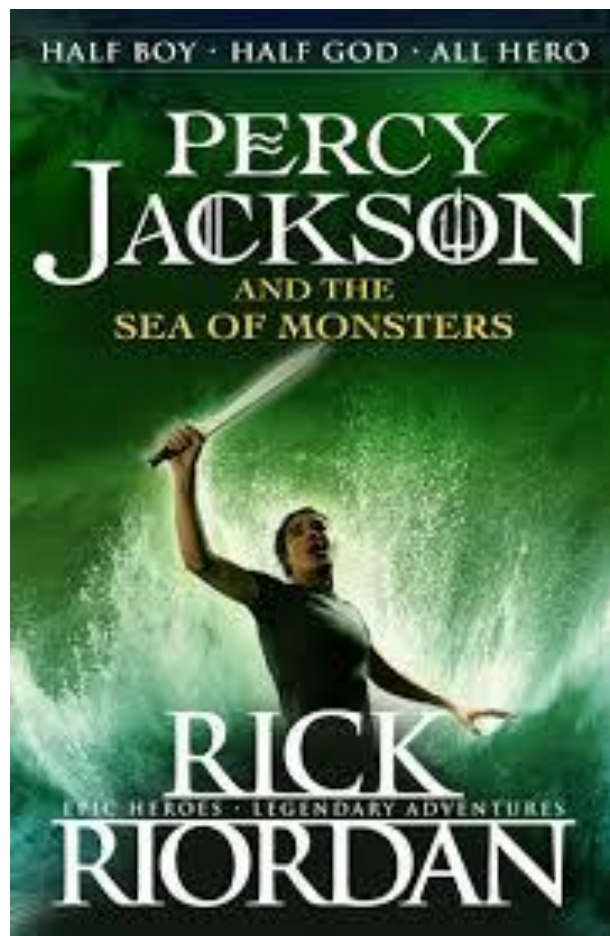
The Percy Jackson series is my favourite series but this is my favourite book because so much happens.
