



Behaviour Expectations Covid-19

All behaviour expectations are based upon inclusion, common sense, mutual respect, and a desire to work hard and learn effectively in a safe and happy environment.

Behaviour expectations are clear and easily understood and remain unchanged except for the addition of the following:

Behaviour during partial reopening:

- Everyone is expected to follow the Government guidelines on social distancing and staying safe.
- Everyone is expected to behave in such a way that keeps everyone else safe.
- Everyone is expected to bring their own equipment and not share with or lend to anyone else.

Consequences during partial reopening:

- Anyone attempting to infect another, whether real or pretend, with the Covid-19 virus will be given a fixed term exclusion and will be removed from site.
- Anyone failing to follow the Covid-19 related instructions of a member of staff will be removed from the classroom and interviewed by the headteacher/member of the senior team. Parents will be informed.
