

Medical Tracker



This week, we are introducing a digital Medical Tracker to help us manage and record pupil's health information more efficiently. This secure online tool allows staff to log accidents, injuries, first aid given and any medication administered during the school day. It also helps us to monitor patterns and communicate important updates more quickly, to ensure that every child receives consistent care. The system is paperless. If your child receives first aid or medication at school, you will be notified electronically: a letter will be sent to your email address. It is therefore vital that we hold an accurate, current email address for you. If you need to update the contact information that we hold for you, please speak to the Office or to your class teacher.
