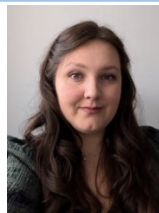


Leadership Message

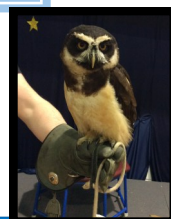

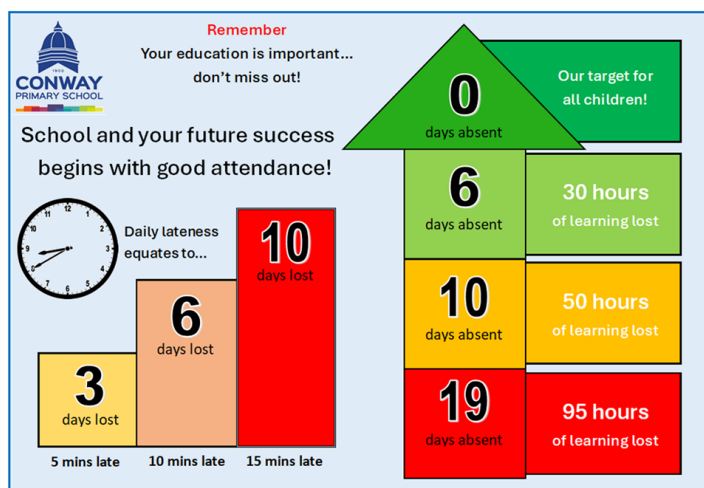
