Children learn from what they see. Show them how you set **goals** and work toward them, no matter how big or small. Talk about people who have overcome obstacles to achieve great things.

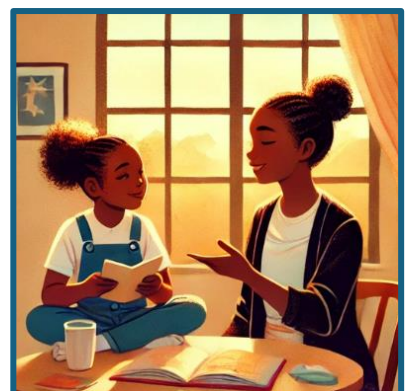
### **Get Involved**

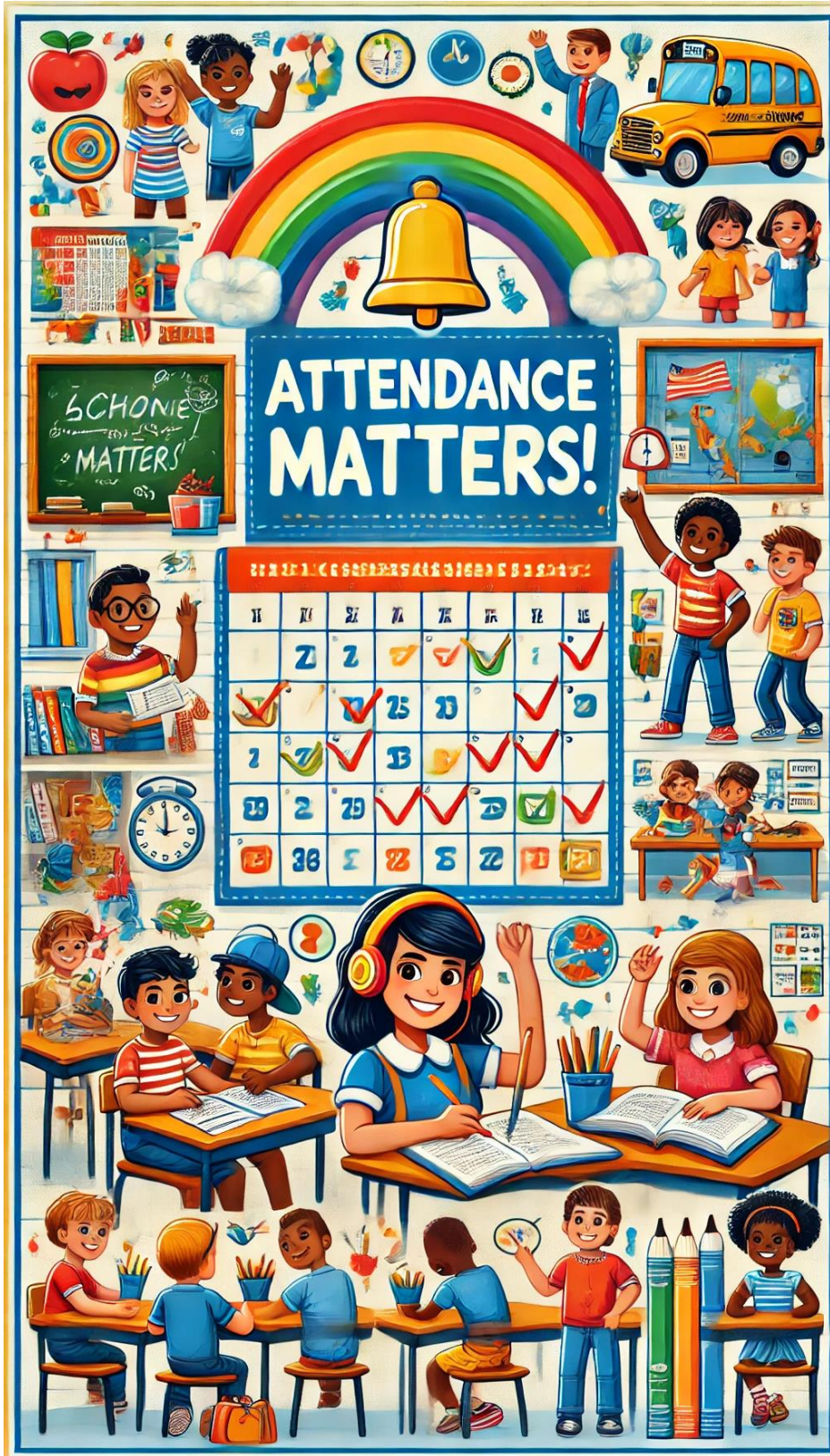

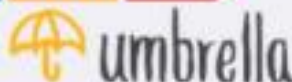
