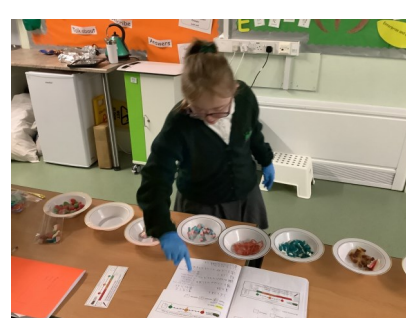
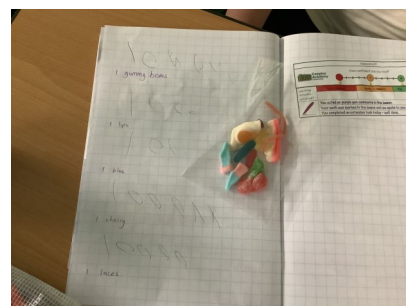
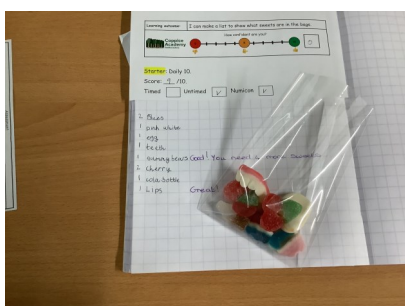
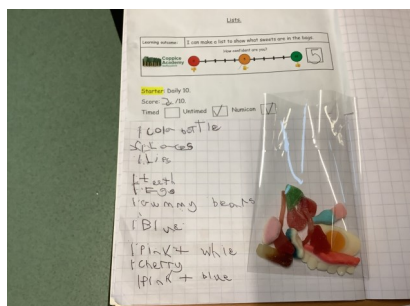
## Forest School with Ash
