#### Mrs Ahearn's Half Term Message




After a very busy start to the year, half term has arrived. Unfortunately, my recovery is taking a little bit longer than expected but I hope to be back soon.


"I am burning the city now, turning laser eyes on to destroy the whole city now" said Crashing Bot.
