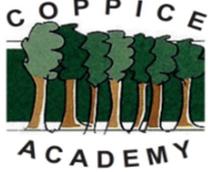




Hola to Enrichment Last Week
