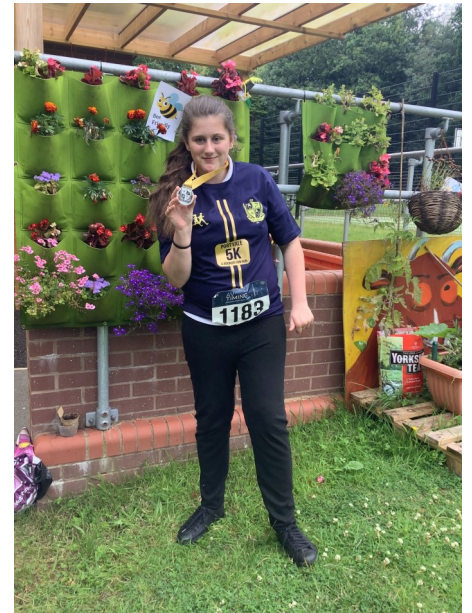
Running Achievement
