Dear Parent/Carer

I wanted to write to you to confirm the procedure in relation to absences associated with COVID-19.

Can you please refer to the table below for guidance on when your child should isolate, or continue to attend school as normal.

All absences should be reported to the school as soon as possible.

Please note that at no time if there are any doubts with your childs symptoms should your child be sent to school on transport due to the risk of passing to other students or the drivers/escorts.

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> If your child has been off school due to Covid symptoms or a family member who is displaying symptoms, awaiting results or received a Covid result, can you please phone the school **BEFORE** your child returns to school. Failure to do this could lead to your child being sent home on arrival.

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I appreciate that these times are worrying but would like to reassure you that all current government guidance in relation to educational settings is in practice and the safety of all of our students and staff is paramount.
