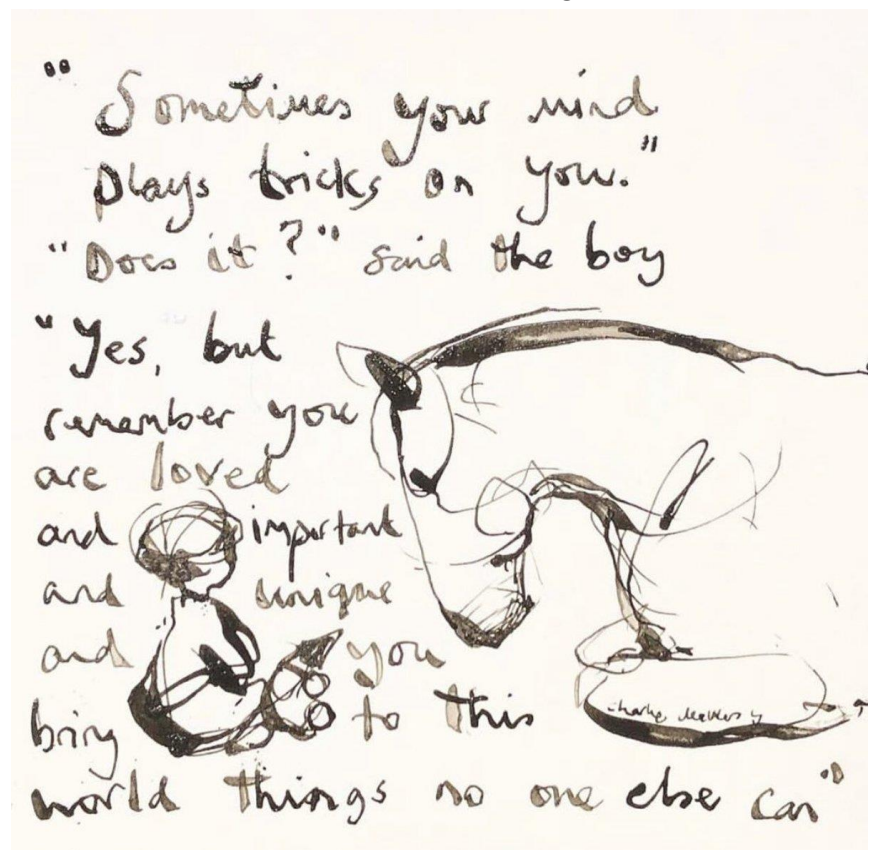


## Children's Mental Health week.
