Lancashire Music service have asked us to share the following information:-



Lancashire Music Service is offering flute and clarinet lessons at school. Lessons usually take place on Tuesday mornings and you can enrol for them on the Music Service website under the Parental Direct Payment (PDP) scheme. Simply go to www.lancashiremusichub.co.uk and select "Enrol" to take you to the relevant pages. There is the option to have group lessons at £7.50 per lesson or individual 20, 30 or 40 minute lessons (£12 - £18 depending on the time selected). There is also an excellent instrument hire scheme enabling you

to hire a flute or clarinet from Lancashire Music Service for the year at a very reasonable rate. This includes a service whereby instruments in need of repair are collected from school and a new one is provided with no further charae.

If your child is interested in learning then they are welcome to go and see the teacher, Mrs. Edwards, when she is in school on Tuesday morning and she will be happy to show them the instruments and explain a little more about them. They can also talk to the current learners and ask any questions.
