Lancashire Music Service is offering flute and clarinet lessons at school. Lessons usually take place on Tuesday mornings and you can enrol for them on the Music Service website under the Parental Direct Payment (PDP) scheme. Simply go to <u>www.lancashiremusichub.co.uk</u> and select "Enrol" to take you to the relevant pages. There is the option to have group lessons at £7.50 per lesson or individual 20, 30 or 40 minute lessons (£12 - £18 depending on the time selected). There is also an excellent instrument hire scheme enabling you

to hire a flute or clarinet from Lancashire Music Service for the year at a very reasonable rate. This includes a service whereby instruments in need of repair are collected from school and a new one is provided with no further charge.

### **School lunches**
