I would also like to make you aware of a very generous offer from a school family who would like to pay towards individual instrumental lessons for your child.

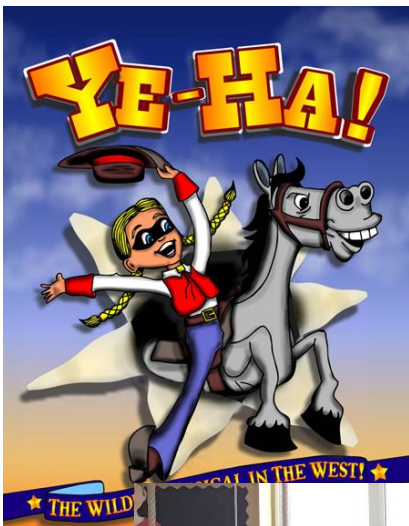
