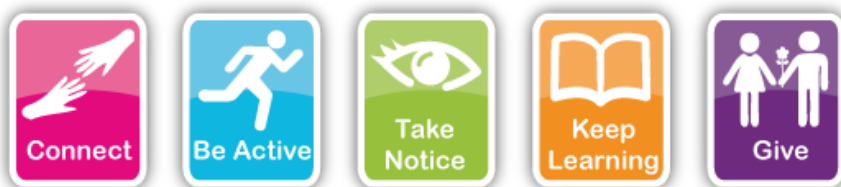

I trust that over this period you have spoken to your child's class teacher or another member of staff. It is really important we are able to keep in touch with all of our school family.


