Youth Group meets on Fridays in school term time, from 4.30pm to 6.00pm in St John's Hall, Hewlett Street PR7 5AB.

St Michael's applications

If your child has just started year 4, and you are thinking of applying in September 2025 for a place at St Michael's Church of England High School starting in September 2026, and you are not already attending church at least twice a month, you might like to think about starting now.

St Michael's admissions (as available on their website) prioritise:

- first of all children in public care, previously looked after children and those with special needs;
- secondly, children where "Parent or child is a regular fortnightly worshipper at a
 foundation church ... Regular fortnightly worship attendance is defined as a
 minimum of twice per month for a period of no less than 2 years up to the 1st
 September in the year of application for admission to the school."

Both Coppull Parish Church and St John's Church, Coppull, are foundation schools. Attendance at Sunday services at either or both of these churches "counts towards" St Michael's admission, as does attendance at our Thursday morning Holy Communion service, held at 11.00am in St John's Church.

Please note that this admissions policy is set by St Michael's School, not by me or by anyone else at St John's Church or Coppull Parish Church.

Attending church brings many benefits in addition to school admissions, and anyone is welcome to attend any of our services!
