## Celebration and rewards

We have a number of opportunities throughout the week when we will celebrate with children, our shining stars, team points, postcards home, stickers and special mentions will continue. This year we will continue the very successful 'Always Ready' jumper; this will be awarded to a child in each class during Monday morning assembly. The children are invited to wear the green jumper for the week as recognition that they are 'Always Ready...' with the teacher completing this sentence as it is awarded. The jumpers have been purchased by school and will be freshly laundered each Friday before presenting to a new child the following Monday. These jumpers do not need to be named but do need to be in school each day.
