Lancashire Music Service is offering a range of instrumental lessons here at school. You can enrol for them on the Music Service website under the Parental Direct Payment (PDP) scheme. Simply go to www.lancashiremusichub.co.uk and select "Enrol" to take you to the relevant pages. There is the option to have group lessons at £7.50 per lesson or individual 20, 30 or 40 minute lessons (£12 - £18 depending on the time selected).

There is also an excellent instrument hire scheme enabling you to hire from Lancashire Music Service for the year at a very reasonable rate. This includes a service whereby instruments in need of repair are collected from school and a new one is provided with no further charge.

Currently we have children learning the drums, clarinet, keyboard, guitar and ukulele. It would be wonderful to see more children achieving this lifelong skill.
