Year 6 children and their parents/carers are invited to an Introduction to Confirmation in Coppull Parish Church at 4.40pm on Friday 15th October.

Confirmation is an opportunity to say in public that you believe in God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and are committed to following Him.

It's an opportunity to make for yourself the promises that were made on your behalf when you were baptized/christened.

Because confirmation is about making a personal commitment, independent of parents and godparents, confirmation is reserved for people in school year 6 and older.

If you're interested in getting confirmed, please come if you can to our Introduction to Confirmation in Coppull Parish Church at 4.30pm on Friday 15th October. This session is for candidates and their parents. If you're interested, but can't make this date or time, please let me know.

Confirmation Classes will be run on Friday afternoons, between 4.30pm and 5.30pm in Coppull Parish Church (either in the vestry, or in the main church, depending on the number of candidates!). These sessions will be for the candidates themselves.

Confirmation Classes will be held on Fridays: 12th, 19th & 26th November; 3rd December; 7th, 14th, 21st & 28th January.

Rev. Mike Keulemans and I will be running the Confirmation Classes together.

If you are interested in getting confirmed, but cannot make Fridays at 4.30pm, please let me know. Attending Introduction to Confirmation or Confirmation Classes does not commit you to getting confirmed. Indeed, the point of the preparation is to enable you to make the confirmation promises with integrity, so if you decide it's not right for you, there will be no pressure to go through with the Confirmation service. (You may decide that it's not right for you this year, but that need not rule out getting confirmed in the future.)

Confirmation service venues and dates have not yet been announced, but we are hoping for a Confirmation service around February 2022.
