## Swimming Information July 2021

Swimming and water safety are an extremely important part of the PE curriculum at Corpus Christi Catholic Primary School as we know it is a lifesaving skill. Swimming is also another way of helping children to lead healthy and active lives.

Normally, pupils in Years 4 and 5 attend swimming lessons across the academic year with additional opportunities for pupils in Year 6 who have not yet met the national curriculum requirements to have booster swimming lessons in the Autumn and Summer term of Year 6. As a result of Covid-19 swimming lessons were significantly affected due to pool closures. Therefore, once swimming provision reopened, we prioritised Year 6 attending swimming lessons with additional booster catch-up sessions and intensive swimming weeks.

Pupils are grouped according to their ability and are taught to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively (for example front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke)
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
