Our 'Virtues to Live By' for the Summer term are:


- Confidence and Determination

To the children









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In Science this week, Year 1 have also been looking at the difference between wild plants and garden plants. They enjoyed spending time outside looking for them.






Reception have been exploring odd and even numbers this week. They had lots of fun designing their own odd and even aliens.
