We began the school year by focusing on our school code of conduct whilst looking at the virtues of Respect and Courtesy.

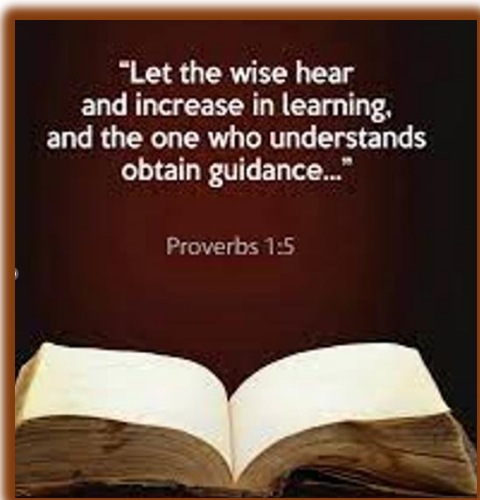
This year we will continue developing the concept of growing in God's love and developing our virtue literacy by focusing on the Christian virtues of

Group tours of our school will be held and dates will be on the website soon. Places must be booked so please contact the school office once dates are announced.



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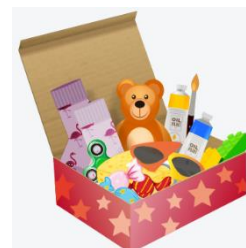
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Shoe Box Appeal

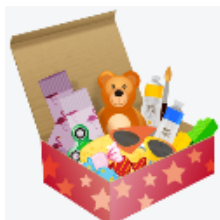

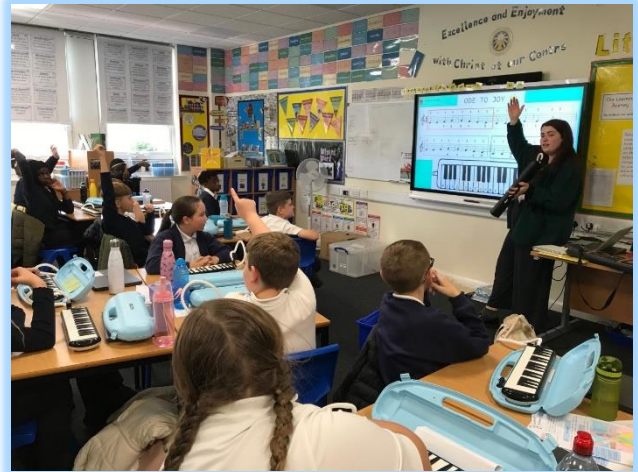

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This week in **Year 1/2** the children have been very busy.
In Art, they have been learning about how to use their bodies to make a Human Alphabet!

In PE, they have been learning how to 'track' others and to find space. They have also been practising about balancing and jumping; the children were able to jump and measure jump by placing a bean bag behind their feet when they had landed. There were some huge jumps!

In our Science topic, the children have been learning about animals including humans. This week's lesson focused on the children matching offspring with their adults. The children also expanded their learning by putting the animals into groups of amphibians, mammals, fish, birds or reptiles.





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This week, Year 4/5 worked with Mr. D to create a delicious coleslaw. The children peeled and grated their carrots, apples and cabbage as well as some ginger before adding them to a bowl and mixing with low fat yoghurt. It was amazing to see so many children tasting what they had made. Well done Year 4/5 and thank you Mr D!
