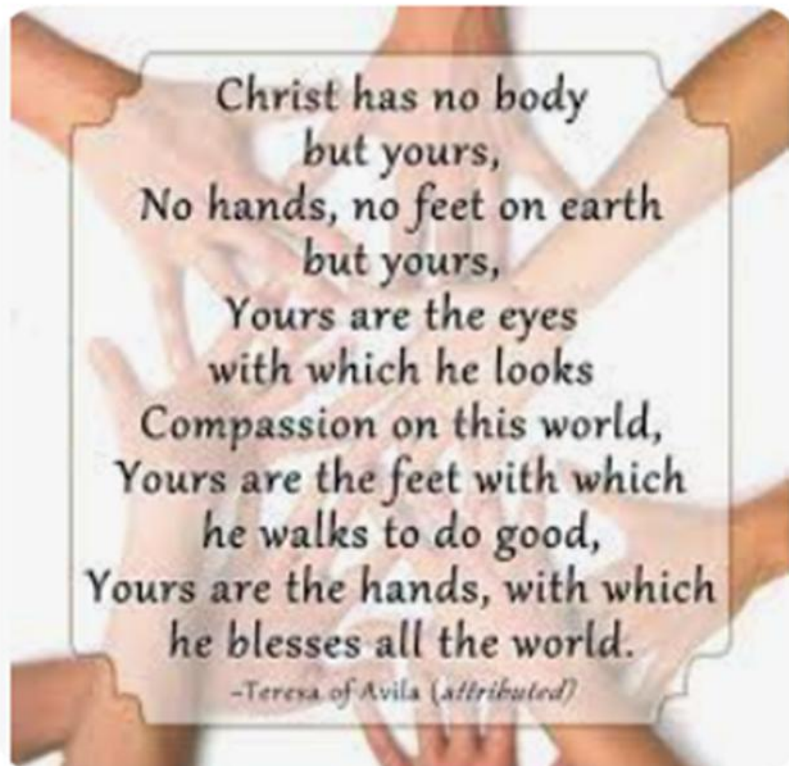

Everyone has done an incredible job – keep it up! 🌟👏



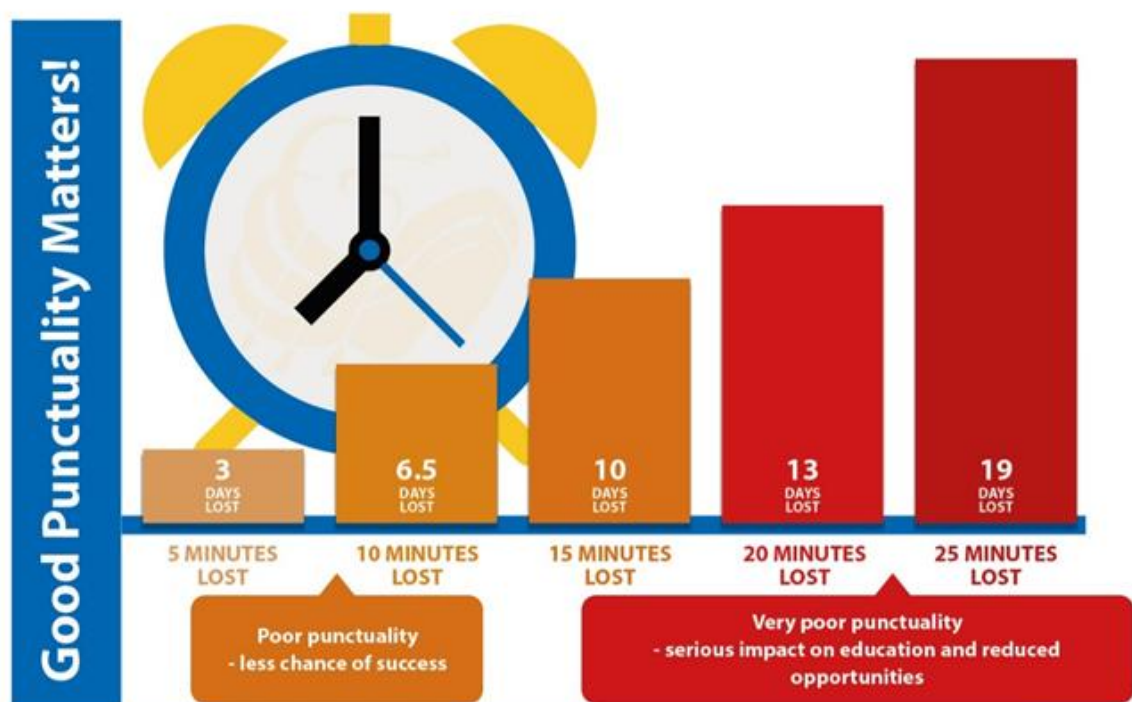
