Trip to the Royal Armouries.







Last Friday, Years 3, 3/4 and 4 visited the Royal Armouries to learn about their History Topic Ancient Greece. The children looked at weapons from Ancient Greek times and then took part in an acting workshop retelling the myth of Perseus and Medusa; a myth that the children are currently writing about in literacy. Afterwards the children became Spartans using wooden swords and shields and learnt how the Greek army trained and moved in battle.
