
Attendance

Covid Testing:

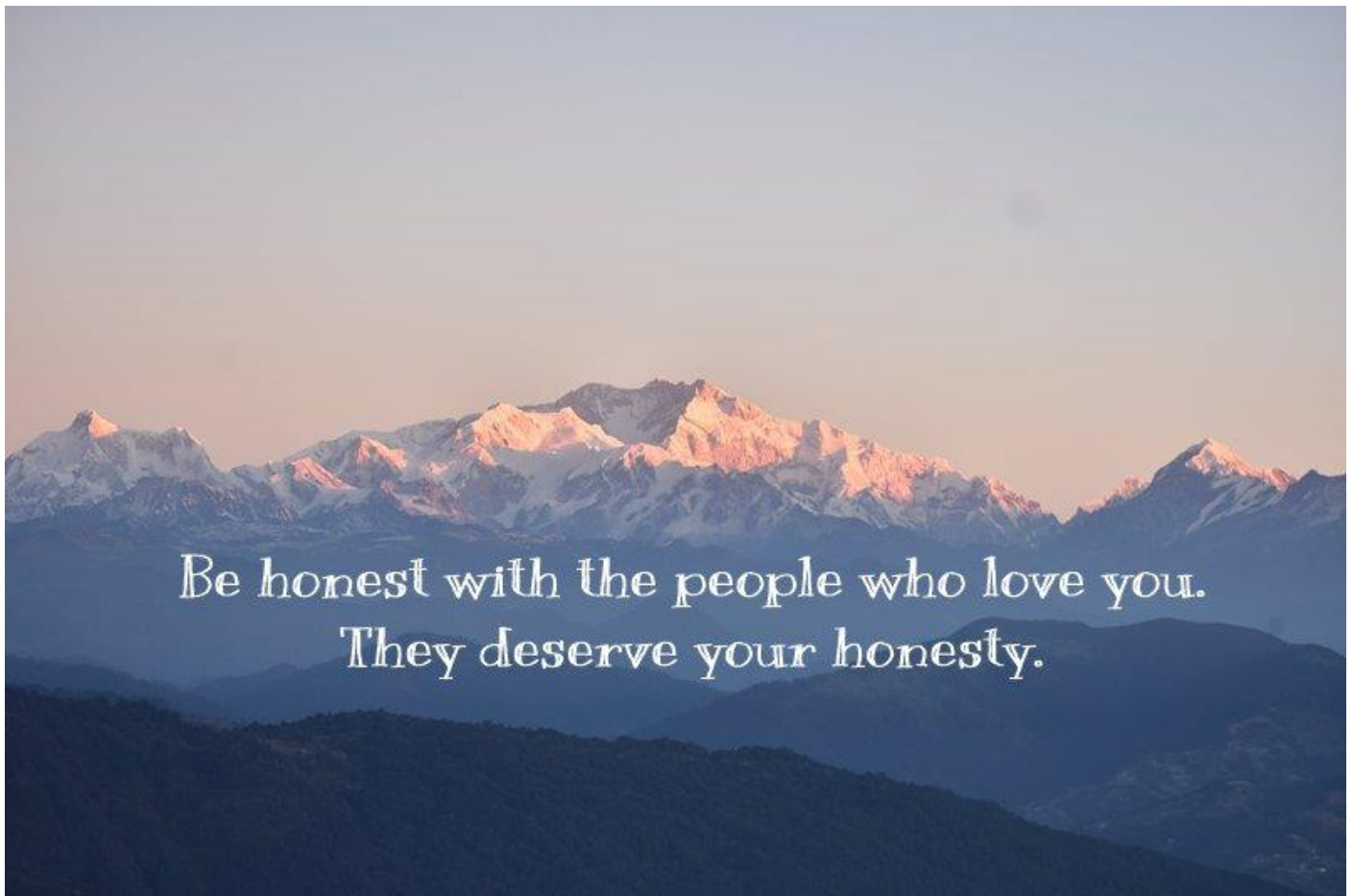
A reminder that all parents/families can access home testing with Lateral Flow Devices (LFDs). Please be aware that these Lateral Flow Devices are for asymptomatic testing

I strongly encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to keep everyone safe. You can just visit a pharmacy and pick up these tests, alternatively use the link below to order your twice weekly tests.
