You are the shoulders that umbrella the team, you are the roof, the structure, the solid.

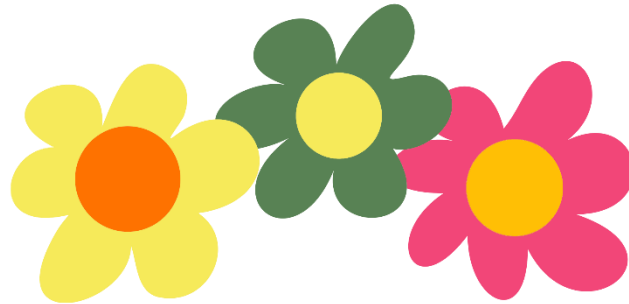
