What is a blog?

A blog is a website or webpage that is regularly updated by the author. A blog also allows the reader to post comments or opinion based on what is written.

Vocabulary

Audience - In this case the readership of the blog.

<u>Blog</u> - A regularly updated website or web page, typically one run by an individual or small group, that is written in an informal or conversational style.

<u>Blog page</u> – A webpage onto which blog posts are hosted.

<u>Blog post</u> - A piece of writing or other item of content published on a blog.

<u>Collaborative</u> - Produced by or involving two or more parties working together.

<u>Icon</u> - A symbol or graphic representation on a screen.
