# Cookery Class

# **Year 3/4**

On Thursday, Mr D visited Year 3/4 to make salmon fish fingers. First, the children made breadcrumbs by slicing bread using the claw method, toasting it and breaking it up to make breadcrumbs. Then the children chopped some coriander and mixed it with the breadcrumbs they had made.

They whisked eggs and dipped the salmon pieces into the egg to help the breadcrumbs stick to the salmon. Finally, the children rolled the salmon pieces in the coriander and breadcrumb mix and placed them into the oven to bake.
